 Baccala and Adam Penner. Demonstrations of tools and processes that have been implemented to
 improve efficiency and profitability.
- New this year: Panel Discussion instead of doing Round Tables, we are going to have an open discussion with a panel of experts. This will give everyone the opportunity to ask questions and hear answers from a group of experts in the field.
- Stress Management: Dealing with the stresses that come from owning and running a small business.
